



TMB LETTER – TS/P ON RESPONSIBLE BUSINESS PRACTICES AND SUSTAINABILITY REPORTING

Dear ISO Members,

We hope this letter finds you well.

During the 96th TMB Meeting, held on 24–25 June 2026, the TS/P proposal on *Responsible Business Practices and Sustainability Reporting* was reviewed by the TMB in accordance with clause 1.5.5 of the ISO/IEC Directives.

Following this review, the TMB adopted TMB Resolution 70/2026.

TECHNICAL MANAGEMENT BOARD RESOLUTION 70/2026

Adopted at the 96th meeting of the Technical Management Board, Madrid, 24-25 June 2026

Review of TS/P proposal on Responsible Business Practices and Sustainability Reporting

The Technical Management Board,

Confirms that the review of TS/P on Responsible Business Practices and Sustainability Reporting has been completed in accordance with clause 1.5.5 of the ISO/IEC Directives,

Decides in principle to establish a new Technical Committee on Responsible Business Practices and Sustainability Reporting, subject to approval through the ISO Members' consultation to evaluate the level of engagement and interest in this area of work,

Allocates the secretariat of the new technical committee to BSI (United Kingdom), considering that Secretariat and Chair twinning arrangements will be established with ABNT (Brazil) if approved,

Decides in principle to establish a new Subcommittee on Sustainable Development Goals management, subject to approval through the ISO Members' consultation,

Allocates the new subcommittee's secretariat to DS (Denmark) if approved,

Decides in principle to establish a new Subcommittee on Social Responsibility, subject to approval through the ISO Members' consultation,

Allocates the new subcommittee's secretariat to AFNOR (France) if approved,

Decides in principle to establish a new Subcommittee on Sustainability Reporting, subject to approval through the ISO Members' consultation, and

Allocates the new subcommittee's secretariat to BIS (India) if approved.

Asks the committee and subcommittees to finalize their titles and scopes following their first meeting and submit them to the TMB for approval.

Next Steps and further details:

- **ISO Members' consultation:** As per our usual process, a 12-week ballot will be launched to all ISO Members to assess interest in the proposed area of work and the expected level of engagement.

- **Outcome:** If approved through the ISO Members' consultation, a new Technical Committee on *Responsible Business Practices and Sustainability Reporting* will be established, with the secretariat allocated to BSI (United Kingdom). Secretariat and Chair twinning arrangements will be established with ABNT (Brazil).
- **Subcommittees:** If approved through the ISO Members' consultation, three subcommittees will also be established under the new Technical Committee:
 - a Subcommittee on *Sustainable Development Goals management*, with the secretariat allocated to DS (Denmark);
 - a Subcommittee on *Social Responsibility*, with the secretariat allocated to AFNOR (France); and
 - a Subcommittee on *Sustainability Reporting*, with the secretariat allocated to BIS (India).
- **Titles and scopes:** Following their first meeting, the new committee and subcommittees will finalize their titles and scopes and submit them to the TMB for approval.
